



art submission guidelines

The Schwerdtle Art Department operates on a Macintosh platform, however, we can read most PC files. Please follow these guide lines when sending files. Feel free to contact us for assistance.

1. Save your file in one of these formats:

- Adobe Creative Suite (CS5 and earlier)
- PDF with fonts converted to outline.
- Encapsulated PostScript (EPS)
- High Resolution Black & White Scan (minimum 300 dpi actual size)
Save scanned files in TIFF format. JPEGs are usually screens with jagged edges. They are made for viewing artwork on your computer screen, but they are rarely high enough quality for printing.

2. Specifics of saving your file:

- Convert all fonts to "outlines" (Illustrator), If not converted, include font files for all fonts used in your job.
- Convert all strokes to paths/outlines.

3. When sending email, always include a PDF or view of the artwork Please include precise and accurate information of what your needs are.

CNC Machining or Bottle Tooling Services will require CAD files. Please send in one of these formats.

- DXF, DWG, IGES, and SolidWorks, STP, SLDPRT, X_T
